13	BOURGOGNE ALIGOTE, Domaine Jessiaume (Burgundy) 2008 <i>The "other" white variety from Burgundy, cleaner and crisper than the better known Chardonnay.</i>			£23.95
14	GAVI, TASSAROLA FORNACI, Castellari Bergaglio (Piemonte, Italy) 2010 <i>Clean, elegant aromas of fruit along with mineral notes. Full-bodied, with a crisp, refreshing acidity a fine structure and lengthy finish.</i>			£24.50
15	GEWURZTRAMINER RESERVE, Gustave Lorentz (Alsace, France) 2009/10 <i>The flagship grape variety from the second driest wine region in France. On the nose there is the unmistakable aromas of lychees as well as a cacophony of spices including cloves and cinnamon. BUT this wine is dry! Fantastic with spicier dishes especially prawns.</i>			£24.95
16	SANCERRE, Domaine Bonnard (France) 2010 <i>A fresh and vivacious Sancerre, with lots of zesty fruit, good acidity and a long finish. It has an excellent balance between weight of fruit and acidity.</i>			£25.95
17	CHABLIS, 1er Cru, Vaillons, J. Moreau et Fils (France) 2008/09 <i>One of the best qualities of Chablis available displaying great richness and character. Hints of tropical fruit, freshly baked bread and honey are all present. On the palate the crisp acidity and good length make for one of the best wines to accompany fish.</i>			£32.50

19	CA'LUNGHETTA PINOT GRIGIO BLUSH, IGT (Italy) 2010/11 <i>The grape must is left on the skins for about twelve hours to give the wine its characteristic pale rose colour.</i>	£4.15	£5.90	£16.95

22	CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Torreon de Paredes (Chile) 2009/10 <i>Cabernet Sauvignon is the benchmark varietal of the Rengo district – the wine which best exhibits the uniqueness of the terroir. The wine has pronounced red fruit flavours including cherry and blackberry, with soft tannins and a silky character.</i>			£17.85
23	SHIRAZ, Red Rock (Australia) 2008 <i>Rich, savoury Shiraz from South Eastern Australia with dark chocolate, cinnamon and white pepper on the finish.</i>			£18.25
24	MALBEC, Goyenechea (Argentina) 2009 <i>Good fruit with rich flavours combine with the tannins in this well structured wine to produce an excellent example of what Argentina is capable of.</i>			£19.50
25	CÔTES DU RHÔNE, Mazet (France) 2009 <i>Rich ruby colour with hints of purple. An intense fruity bouquet – red and black berries – with hints of spices and liquorice. An elegant and smooth flavour with a pleasant silky texture.</i>			£19.95
26	BORDEAUX CLARET, Alexis Lichine (France) 2009 <i>Spicy, berry flavours complexed by a touch of mint, dominate this wine. The warm, ripe, savoury fruit results in a soft, rounded palate showing great length.</i>			£20.50
27	RIOJA CRIANZA, Bodegas Beronia (Spain) 2008 <i>Aromas of vanilla, raspberry and cherry dominate the bouquet. The palate is fresh and fruity with a rich and powerful finish.</i>			£20.95
28	BEAUJOLAIS VILLAGES, Henry Fessy (France) 2007/8 <i>A soft, fresh and fruity wine from the Gamay grape, grown on the granite soils of the Beaujolais region and excellent with almost anything.</i>			£21.95
29	CHIANTI CLASSICO, DOCG (Italy) 2008 <i>From the heart of Tuscany this is an excellent red wine to serve with food. It is medium bodied with lovely cherry fruit flavours.</i>			£22.50
30	SHIRAZ, Wynn's Coonawarra Estate (Australia) 2007/08 <i>Aromas reminiscent of ground black pepper, mulberry and raspberry, through to blackberry at the riper end of the spectrum. Oak is used to mature and increase the wines complexity, without dominating its distinctive cool-climate Coonawarra Shiraz characters</i>			£24.95
31	PINOT NOIR, Domaine Jessiaume (Burgundy) 2008 <i>The bouquet is delicate and well-fruited (blackcurrant, raspberry) with a hint of animal in the older wine (musk, smoke). The mouth is supple and reveals good tannins.</i>			£25.75
32	RIOJA, RESERVA, Beronia (Spain) 2005/06 <i>Made from 89% Tempranillo, 6% Mazuelo and 5% Graciano. The wine undergoes 18 months ageing in barrel and a further 2 years in bottle before release. There are hints of chocolate, toasted bread and spice on the nose and a smooth, gentle finish.</i>			£27.95
33	CHÂTEAUNEUF DU PAPE ROUGE, Ogier (Rhône) 2009 <i>Named after the "Popes New Castle" where they would flee to from Avignon in times of trouble, this wine is the pinnacle of winemaking in the Southern Rhône. The law allows the use of 13 different grape varieties but this one only uses three. These wines tend to be quite soft and fruity, best drunk with red meat or cheese.</i>			£29.95
34	DON AMADO Torreón de Paredes, Valle de Rengo (Chile) 2006 <i>An exceptional wine from the oldest vines on the property, cepage is 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot. Hand-picked grapes are fermented in stainless steel, then aged in French oak barrels for 2 years, before bottling without filtration. Very deep in colour, with an attractive full bouquet - mature and firm with well rounded tannins and layers of complex elegance. This wine can be enjoyed now, but also has good capability for ageing.</i>			£39.95
35	CHATEAU TROPLONG MONDOT, Grand Cru Classé, St. Émilion 2007/8 <i>A very special wine for our humble restaurant! This predominantly merlot based red is alive and kicking with soft damson and plum fruit and delicious cedar notes. Powerful, firm with good tannins and a very long finish. Concentrated flavours thanks to the extra old vines.</i>			£65.95
